

## Chemo cap pattern

Need: size 9 16" circular needle  
Double pointed needles  
Stitch marker  
Tapestry needle  
Washable yarn

Using size 9 16" circular needle, cast on 78 stitches. Mark the beginning with a stitch marker.

Knit in the round for 6 inches.

Begin decrease:

\*K5, k2tog\* and repeat from \* to end, k1. (there will be one extra stitch)

Knit the next row and each row between decreases.

\*k4, k2tog\* repeat from \* to end, k1.

Knit.

[At this point, you may need to go to double pointed needles. When you do, be sure to end with a k2tog just before moving to next needle.]

\*K3, k2tog\* repeat from \* to last st; k1.

Knit.

\*K2, K2tog\* repeat from \* to last st; k1.

Knit.

\*K1, K2tog\* repeat from \* to last st; k1.

Knit.

\* K2tog\* repeat from \* to last st; k1.

Knit.

Cut yarn, leaving about 6 inches to weave through.

Using a tapestry needle, thread it and weave through the remaining stitches on the needles and then pull tight. Weave in ends.
